WHAT DIPLOMA?

The European Baccalaureate Diploma (EBBD) is a diploma planned in European co-operation. It is granted to students by accredited schools. EBBD e.V., an international non-profit association registered in Germany determines the accreditation. The business education of Helsinki Business College Ltd. was accredited in 2013.

The diploma is granted to those students who have achieved required skills in international business and whose studies have fulfilled the diploma's technical requirements.

The first EBBD diplomas were granted to students of Vocational Qualification in Business and Administration, who graduated from our college in May 2013.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

In the QBA program, which is taught in English, you will achieve the required skills if your grades are in the first year average 2 and in the second year average 3.

The required level of the first foreign language is B2 (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, CEFR). The required level of the second foreign language is B1. In case your mother tongue is English, please consult your instructor.

You have to stay abroad at least for four weeks. The easiest way is to carry out at least four weeks of your Onthe-job learning abroad. The other option is that you study abroad minimum four weeks and in addition you work in an international company in your home country for at least four weeks.
